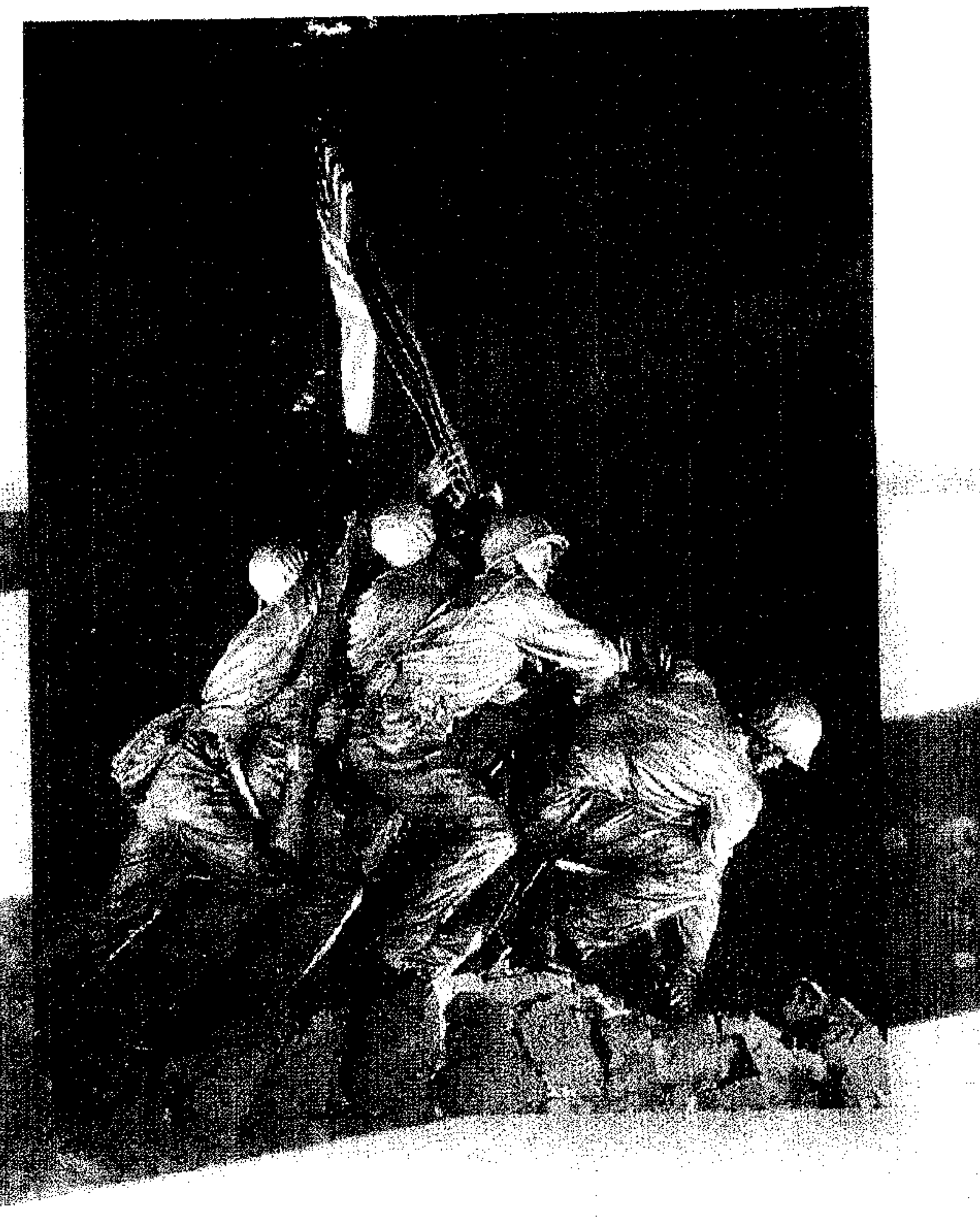

Qualifying for Your Benefit

Many Wartime Veterans can be turned down for their benefits needlessly, simply because they do not understand the qualifications of the program.

Eligibility:

- Have Served 90 days of active duty
- Served at least 1 day during a time of war
- Must be a wartime veteran
- Honorably Discharged
- Must need assistance from another person to perform some tasks of daily living

Common Myths:

- Had to be wounded: **FALSE.** You can qualify even if you were not wounded
- Had to serve overseas: **FALSE.** You can qualify even if you did not serve overseas
- Had to be in battle: **FALSE.** You can qualify even if you were never in battle

Category	Annually	Monthly
Veteran Aid & Attendance without dependent	\$21,096	\$1,758
Veteran Aid & Attendance with one dependent	\$25,020	\$2,085
Two Veterans married to each other	\$33,456	\$2,788
Surviving Spouse Aid & Attendance	\$13,560	\$1,130
